

Join us on Thursday, November 7th at 6pm at The Ordinary Fellow Winery here in Palisade for "Palisade: Then & Now." JoAnn








EXPLORE THE PALISADE HISTORY MUSEUM

HORSE DRAWN CARRIAGE HISTORY TOUR THROUGH RIVERBEND PARK

The Palisade Historical Society and our business member JR's Carriage Service teamed up to host the Fruita Community Center group on a History Tour through Riverbend Park on October 8th!



The group learned about the history of Riverbend Park, from the former CCC (Civilian Conservation Corps) Camp on the eastern end of the park that later housed German Prisoners of War, to the location of the former Migrant Labor Camp on the western end of the park, and the importance of the irrigation canal and river that flow around it.

The Palisade Historical Society participated in the Town of Palisade's Trick or Treat Street on Halloween! It was a Boo-tiful day for it!




